EU Coding Week:

This week has been all about sparking creativity and curiosity in children's learning. The children have had the opportunity to explore their Computational Thinking skills across the curriculum through exploration, problem solving and collaboration. Our Reception children have really enjoyed coding around the classroom, following instructions to collect treasure! Year 4 created models of a Roman town in their classrooms and retold the story of Romulus and Remus by programming our Sphero robots around the town as part of their Roman topic. Year 5 unleashed their creativity by developing their very own Apps and presented in an App Showcase Event! Year 6 delved into the world of Augmented Reality which allowed children to create interactive experiences of a real world environment with digital objects. They created their own scenes linked to their topic, The Plastic Problem, wrote poems about The Ocean and brought them to life in a 3D digital image in the classroom. There were fantastic experiences across the school that allowed for connections to be made and sparked passions at the centre of learning.

The children have been awarded a certificate to recognise that they have developed essential Computational Thinking skills and contributed to the success of EU Code Week 2019!

Reception Class Admissions 2020:

If your child was born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016, your child is due to start Reception in September 2020. You can complete your application online at <https://www.bolton.gov.uk/admissions/primaryschool-places> The closing date for completing your application is by **15 January 2020**. Whilst next September seems a long time away, it is important you complete your applications by the closing date as places fill up very quickly!
