

Year 2 Curriculum Overview - Autumn Term (2)

Our topic this term is: **Fighting Fit**

English:

In English we will be reading 'Little Red Riding Hood and the Sweet Little Wolf'. We will sequence and discuss the main events in the story as well as discuss key vocabulary within the context of the text. After reading the text, we will make inferences about characters and events using evidence from the text as well as giving opinions and supporting our opinions with reasons. We will have the opportunity to write our own narrative story with a focus on descriptive language, punctuation and conjunctions such as 'and', 'but', 'or'.

For KS1 classes: Phonics will continue on a daily basis and the majority of children will be starting SET 3 in the Read Write Inc scheme, which will teach them about spelling patterns and rules.

Maths:

In Maths, this half term, we will continue to look at place value. This will consist of identifying the place and value of corresponding numbers and then compare.

Following on from this, we will be learning about solving simple word problems using models and then moving onto two-step word problems. We will use model drawings to represent various concepts in addition and subtraction.

Topic/Science:

This half term in Theme, we will be focusing on the stages of growth in humans and the elements that help humans live a healthy life. We will do this by studying the Eatwell guide and the different food groups. We will compare this to the growth of animals and what they need to survive. Additionally, we will be learning about the importance of '5 a day'.
