Plot:

He asks Little Red Riding Hood where she is going and Little Red Riding Hood tells him! He hurries to Grandma's house disguised as the girl and then tricks grandma. What Will the Bog Bad Wolf do next? Will he be able trick Little Red Riding Hood?

Setting:

The story is set in the forest and Grandma's house.
