



Vocabulary

plant	a living thing, often growing from the ground, that used sunlight to make its own food. They may have leaves and a stem and sometimes a flower.
seed	it is what a new plant grows from.
metamorphasis	a process which sees animals changing their physical form drastically in a series of stages.
cocoon	a cocoon is a covering or case made by some animals to protect themselves or their young as they develop into adults.
chrysalis	a chrysalis is the middle stage of a butterfly's metamorphosis, between the larvae (caterpillar) and the adult stage (butterfly).
duckling	a duckling is a baby duck. Ducklings usually learn to swim by following their mother to a body of water.


