Year 4 Curriculum Spring 2 Our topic this term: Passport to Europe

English

Through the use of the 'Talk for Writing' strategy of imitate, innovate and invent, we will be reading Boy Giant and creating our own story based on its structure. We will also be learning about Non Chronological Reports and creating our own information poster with flip-flap facts and information linked to our learning.

Maths

We will continue to practice our timetables up to 12.

One of the topics to be covered this half term is <u>Decimals</u>, which will include multiplication and division of decimals as well as estimating and applying knowledge of decimals into real life scenarios as word problems. The other two topics are <u>Time</u> and <u>Money</u>, which are a fantastic opportunity to enhance children's understanding in their daily life outside the classroom.

Science

We will be learning about Animals including humans. We will be investigating and creating our own tooth paste.

Theme

We will be learning about human and physical features. We will compare places to our own region of Greater Manchester and climates. Using our iPads, we are going to explore the major landmarks of the world.

Our Design Technology lessons will focus on designing, making and evaluating their favourite meals.

As part of our geography, we will be learning about physical and human features of the planet. We will learn about the differences between them and identify key attractions around the world.
