Our topic this term: **Sparks Might Fly!**

English

This half term we will be exploring different types of texts from an explanation text, narrative and finally before half term a play script. Throughout the half term, we will be learning about different types of punctuation, word classes and how the English language works through our Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPaG) lessons. We will also be developing our reading skills through our daily Guided reading lessons where we will develop our vocabulary and learn how to use inference skills to help gain a better understanding of a text.

Maths

We will start our year off with a recap of all of our times-tables. Then, we will begin to look at Number and Place Value. We will learn to read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 1000 and determine the value of each digit. We will count forwards or backwards in steps of powers of 10 for any given number up to 1000. We will also be rounding any number up to 100,000 to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. Other operations we will look at are addition and subtraction. We will use a variety of methods and resources to help us solve problems.

Theme

In Science, we will be looking at electricity and how we use it in our daily lives. We will also be making our very own circuits which we will use to power our nightlights which we create in D&T. In geography, we will be exploring where we get our electricity from and the many different ways of creating it such as renewable and non-renewable sources.

As part of our Relationships, Health Education this half term, the children will be exploring how the family dynamic works including the extended family along with how we can make positive friendships with those around us.
