Transition for new pupils starting Reception:

We will be holding an open day on the 13th July for the parents of pupils starting in reception. This will allow parents to visit the school, meet their child's new teachers and ask any questions. Information packs for parents will be provided on the day. More information will follow soon.

Transition for pupils moving up classes:

For pupils moving up classes to Years 1 - 6, we will be holding a transition morning on Friday 8th July so that they can familiarise themselves with the classroom, their teachers and daily routines.

Following the transition activities outlined above, the first few weeks of September will be focussed on ensuring the children are comfortable and settled, at which stage we will host our usual 'Meet and Greet' sessions with parents to discuss children's learning.

Transition for Year 6 pupils moving to Secondary:

A third teacher (Mr. H. Neville) will teach pupils from year 6 in the mornings. The class groupings for this will be decided in due course and may change as per the needs of the pupils daily/weekly. In addition, Mrs. Z. Nanji, Mrs. S. Kovariwala, Miss. A. Pandor, Mrs. M. Patel, Miss. L. Collins and Mrs. S. Khatun will provide teaching cover across the school.

Attendance and punctuality:

As always, we would like to remind you of the importance of ensuring your child(ren) attend school daily and on time, unless they are unwell. To celebrate regular punctuality and attendance we hold an awards ceremony at the start of each term and children are awarded prizes and certificates for recognising their punctuality and attendance above the school's target of 96%. Please ensure you are providing your child with every opportunity to be considered for an award by ensuring they attend school on time, every day. Although school officially starts at 8:40am, we always open the gates from 8:30am onwards and have a breakfast club (free for pupils who are eligible for incomerelated free school meals).

Domestic Violence (Operation Encompass):

We are involved in 'Operation Encompass' - the purpose of which is to safeguard and support children and young people who have been involved in or witness to a domestic abuse incident. This involves working in partnership with the police and social services. Following the report of an incident of domestic abuse, by 9.00am on the next school day, our safeguarding team will be informed that the child or young person has been involved in a domestic incident. This allows the provision of immediate intervention dependent upon the needs of the child. For further information please refer to the safeguarding page of our website.

Mental Health Services

Kooth & Qwell are online mental health services, providing free, safe and anonymous mental health and wellbeing support in Bolton. Kooth.com is available for ages 11-25, while Qwell.io is available for those aged 26+. There are no costs, no waiting lists, no referrals and no criteria required to access the service, which is accredited by the British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP) and delivered by Kooth plc, the UK's largest digital mental health provider. Users can access peer to peer support through moderated discussion boards, and self help resources including magazine articles and activities. They also offer online text-based counselling and support from qualified counsellors and emotional wellbeing practitioners, who are available from 12 noon - 10pm on weekdays and from 6pm - 10pm on weekends. Parents/carers are invited to meet the school SENDCo and to see a presentation on Kooth and Qwell community support. The provisional date for this is: Monday 4th July from 9.30 to 10.30.
