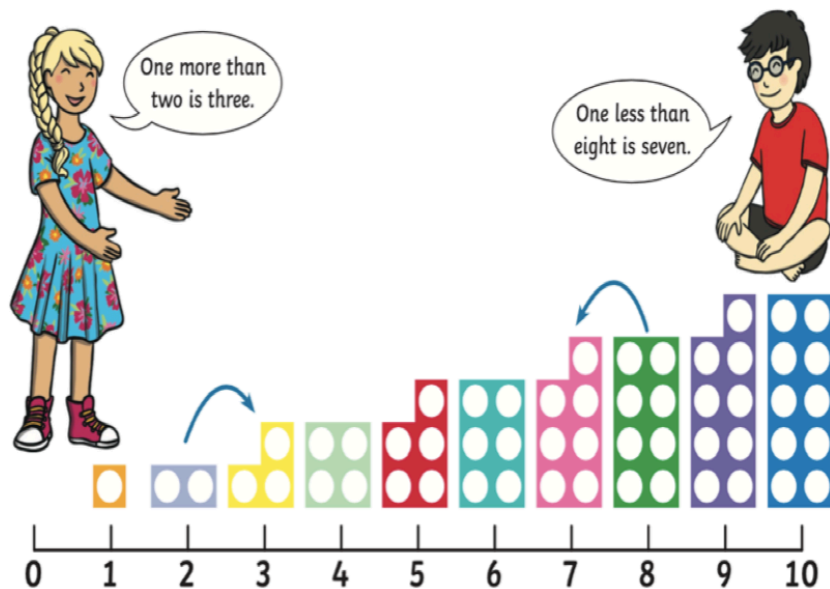


...and count back?

What will help us to find one more or one less?

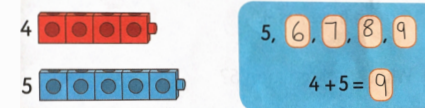


## addition
