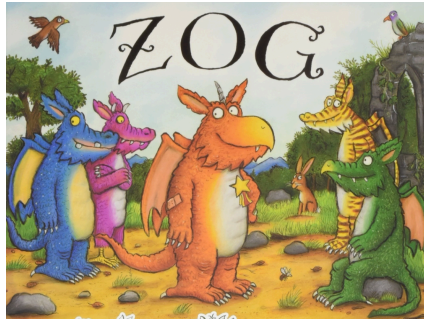


Fire! Fire! English

Key Vocabulary

plot - the story line or order of events in a book

setting - the place that a story is set

characters - a person in a story

prediction - the act of telling or trying to tell what will happen in the future

poem - a poem is made up of words and some words rhyme

rhyming words - a word that ends with the same or almost the same sound as another word

contents - tells you what is in the book in order

caption - a sentence that explains what is happening in a picture
