**Middle Ages** - a period of European history from 1000AD to 1453 AD

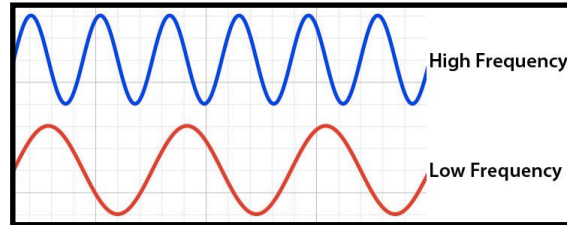
**peasant** - a poor person

## Science: Sound



**pitch:** Is used to describe if a sound is high or low.

**vibrations:** a back and forth motion that produces sound. Smaller back and forth motions will cause a higher pitch sound while larger back and forth motions will create a lower pitched sound

**volume:** this term is used to describe how loud or quiet a sound is. The volume often gets lower as the object making the sound moves further away.

## Geography: Environmental study

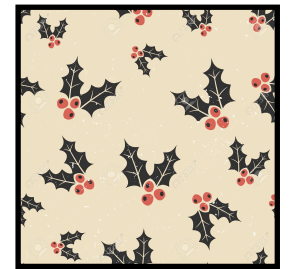
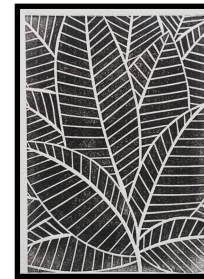
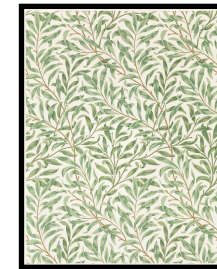
**recycling:** the process of turning waste into reusable material
