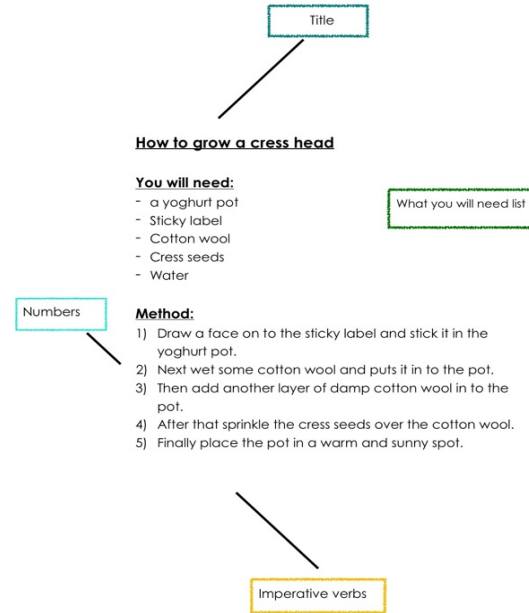
### Setting:

The story is set on the farm where the turnip has been growing underground.

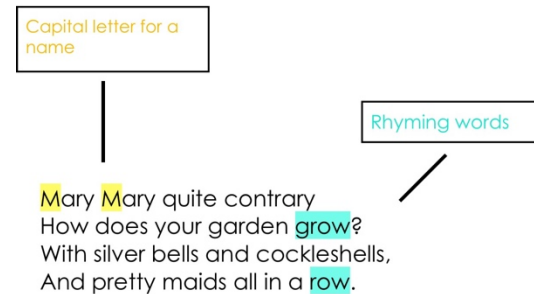
### Characters:
