dentist	check and treat dental issues
doctor	treats people who are ill or sick
fire fighter	someone who helps to put out fires
nurse	helps to treat ill or sick people
postal worker	delivers letters and parcels
teacher	helps children to learn
vet	looks after ill animals
police officer	a person who is a member of a police force and protects the public
paramedic	helps to look after hurt or sick people in an emergency
safe	protected from danger

Did you know...

Dial **999** in case of emergency.

It is really bad to call 999 if it isn't an emergency - slows them down in helping people who do need help.

Emergency services are: police, ambulance, fire service, coastguard, mountain rescue AND cave rescue.
