




Diary entries



A diary entry captures and recalls events that occurred during the day. The most important events of the day are included and written about in order.

Diary entries are written in the first person (I, we, my, our) and include feelings, thoughts and opinions. A non - chronological report gives people information about something or someone. A non chronological report has a title, an introduction, sub-headings and pictures with captions.





Key vocabulary:

sailor – someone who works on a boat or a ship

voyage - a long journey by sea, air or land

crew – a group of people who work together

continent - one of the earth's seven major areas of land

ocean – a large area of salt water

island – an area of land smaller than a continent and surrounded by sea

astronaut – a person who is trained to travel to space

space mission - a journey made into space

significant individual - a person who is famous / remembered for something important
