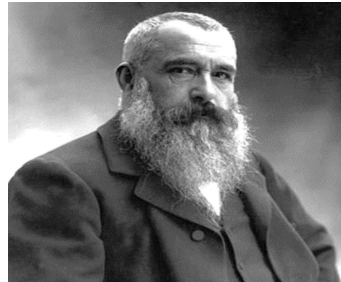

The **texture** is how it tastes or feels in your mouth.

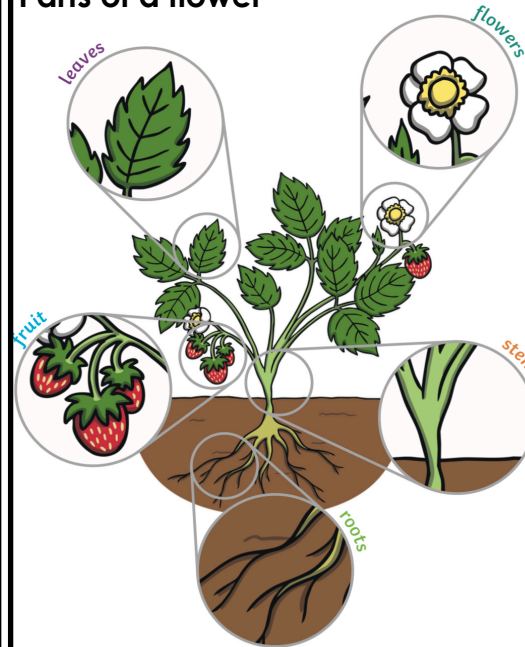
A **fruit salad** is a mixture of different types of chopped fruit served in syrup or juice.

### Parts of a flower



### Key Vocabulary:

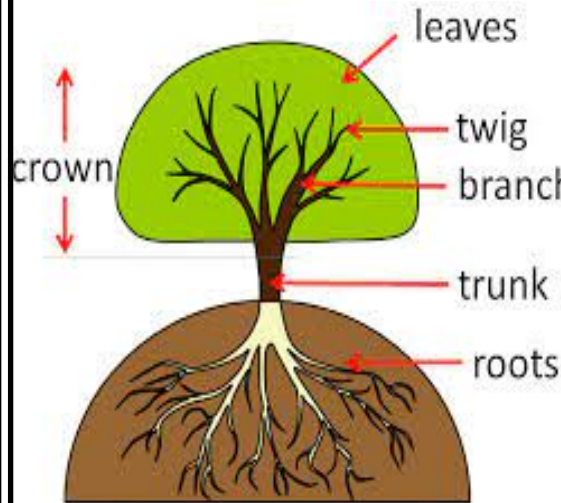
**bark** - the outer covering of tree

**branches** - grows out from the trunk on which the flowers and fruit grow

**trunk** - the thick main stem of a tree

**flower** - the coloured part of a plant from which the fruit or seeds develop

### Parts of a tree



**leaves** - flat green part of a plan growing from the stem

**roots** - the part of the plant which grows under the ground and absorbs water or minerals that it sends to the rest of the plant

**stem** - the long thin part from which the leaves grow
